



## Positive Action and Positive Attitude Rules

Please MAIL this form to the PRIDE office prior to the first day of camp!

1. Participants **may not** arrive late or leave and return unless in an emergency situation.
2. All participants who drive (Action Camp only) their own cars must park them in an area designated for the camp.
3. All prescriptions, vitamins, nutritional supplements, and over-the-counter drugs must be turned in at registration and will be kept by PA staff. The staff may allow participants to keep inhalers and other medications that are designed for emergency use. Personal Medications will be made available by the staff to the participants throughout the day as needed. Please note that we expect **participants to be responsible for remembering to take their medications as well**. All prescriptions, vitamins, nutritional supplements, and over-the-counter drugs must be in their original containers. Participants are responsible for picking up all medications during check-out on the last day.  
  
PRIDE will offer traditional over the counter first aid medications to participants as requested (i.e. Advil, Tylenol, etc) unless otherwise noted on the medical form.
4. At **no time** will males or females be permitted into the sleeping rooms of the opposite gender unless accompanied by adult staff for small group meetings.
5. Participants **will not** be permitted to leave the camp area under any circumstances or have guests visit unless special permission is granted by the PA Camp Director.
6. Participants will be expected to participate in and be punctual for all scheduled activities.
7. Participants should notify a staff member immediately in the event of illness or injury. Parents will be notified in the event of serious illness or injury.
8. NO alcohol, tobacco, or use of any other illegal drug is allowed at PA. Vape pens are also prohibited. Violators will be sent home and subject to arrest.
9. If you bring a cell phone it must remain in your room except during approved free time. If seen by a staff member or intern, it may be confiscated. PA is designed to be a "retreat" style event and distractions should be at a minimum.
10. No computers, TV's, video games, or other electronic equipment may be brought to PA., except for ipod's/I-Phones or cd players with headphones which may only be used during the participant's free time. Participants are responsible for their valuables and PRIDE Resource is not liable for loss or theft of items.
11. Quiet time and sleeping hours must be observed and will be enforced. PA is a long, full week and participants need rest in order to get the most from it.
12. Casual attire is appropriate for PA. Many activities are outside and students should dress comfortably. However, NO short shorts/skirts, no halters, spaghetti strap, strapless, one strap shirts, or clothes with inappropriate messages are allowed.
13. Participants should refrain from bringing decorations for their rooms. In addition, the rooms will be crowded so there is not a lot of room for luggage and extra items. Nothing may be taped to the walls of the sleeping rooms.

**Infraction of any of the above rules may lead to immediate dismissal from the P.A.**
